

Dear T&T Parents -

Welcome to Truth & Training for the 2023-24 year. We are looking forward to learning how to discover what grace is this year in our "Discovery of Grace" book with your 3rd-5th grade child.

For incoming 3rd graders and those new to T&T: T&T is set up so that we all work together on the same lesson every week. This allows the clubbers and the leaders to really dive into our topic of the week. It teaches your child to do a bible study every week on his/her own, come together with others to hear a group lesson and then spend time discussing what they learned. It is a wonderful opportunity to help your child learn to take ownership of his/her faith while learning more about God, the Bible and Jesus.

Best tips to support your child:

- Encourage your child to complete their study *every week* prior to coming to club. Lessons take 15-20 minutes to complete. Please make this a priority.
- Attached is our weekly schedule, so you can help them stay on track with the correct section for the week. *Additionally* we have included the memory verse we'll be focusing on, so that you can talk about this with your child.
- If your child misses a week, encourage them to make up the missed lesson with a leader before club starts (between 6:15-6:30pm). Books cannot be completed with missing sections.
- Post the memory verse where your child can see it. While memorization is not required, it is encouraged.
- If your child is looking for an extra challenge - there are silver and gold extra credit sections. These sections should get checked off before club starts (6:15-6:30).
- Review sections at the end of each unit are *optional*.

Weekly Schedule:

- 6:15-6:30 - drop off in classrooms. 2501 - girls T&T/2500 - boys T&T
- 6:30-6:55 - large group teaching
- 6:55-7:25 - small group table time
- 7:25-8:00 - Game-Time
- 8:00 - dismissal (all grades dismissed without parent pick-up)

Other useful information:

- Game-time happens in 4 different spaces (Mark 12:30) - Clubhouse is large muscle games (strength), Chill Room is games and quieter activities - fun with friends (soul), "BAT" room (Bible and Trivia) will offer a deeper dive into our lesson of the day (mind) and our new room will have fun service and character building activities (heart).

Clubber Expectations:

- Bring book and bible
- Wear uniform/participate in theme night
- Come with verse and study prepared
- Participate in discussion
- Regular attendance
- Engage during game-time
